INTRODUCING OUR FAMILY SUCCESS PROGRAM

At Housing Up, we are constantly improving our services and adapting to the needs of the families we serve. We have recently implemented a new initiative, the Family Success Program (FSP), to accelerate our families' progress toward independence and financial success.

The incentive-based program, which is currently being offered to residents of our affordable housing properties, assesses participants' needs and strengths in areas such as education, employment and financial management. The FSP team then coordinates the necessary services and resources to help families achieve their goals, and routinely monitors their progress.

We look forward to sharing the accomplishments of families enrolled in the program throughout the year.
