PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (PSH) is a long-term program for chronically homeless families or households with physical and/or mental disabilities.

HOUSING FIRST MODEL is an evidence-based approach to ending homelessness that prioritizes quickly moving families experiencing homelessness into permanent housing without preconditions like employment or sobriety.

RESIDENT SERVICES provide resources such as job training, youth tutoring, and specialized classes to strengthen families, increase their financial independence, and ensure they do not become homeless in the future.
