

THC Purchases Partner Arms 4 in Southeast DC

We are pleased to announce that THC Affordable Housing Inc. has purchased a three-story apartment complex in Southeast DC for the purpose of creating the Partner Arms 4 affordable housing development. [View press release here.](#)



Located at the intersection of Benning Road and Southern Avenue, SE, the 36 units will be for permanent supportive housing and affordable housing residents. Construction will begin in the fall of 2013 and the apartments will be re-opened in early 2014. St. Margaret's parish generated a collection to purchase the beds, linens, and other home items for the mom and children.



David Griswold, THC Board Member and St. Margaret's member, provided a prayer for everyone as the group blessed the new home. At the end of the day, Polly Donaldson, THC Executive Director and St. Margaret's Senior Warden presented Ms. Shuler with a house warming gift from Edith Scott.



Housing Task Force Releases Report


On Tuesday, March 12, 2013, Mayor Vincent Gray announced the release of "Bridges to Opportunity: A New Housing Strategy for DC." The report was produced by the Comprehensive Housing Strategy Task Force which is made up of 36 community leaders including THC's Executive Director, Polly Donaldson. For the last 12 months, the Task Force has been gathering research, held public forums, consulted with local and national experts, and identified best practices. "The goal of the CHSTF was to help city leaders ensure the creation of more affordable housing in the District - because every District resident deserves a decent, safe and affordable place to live." said Mayor Gray.
